

Shop With Scrip & Support CCA

Shop With Scrip is changing the way we shop: gift cards aren't just for gifts anymore! Scrip partnered with hundreds of popular brands and stores to offer rebates to support non-profit organizations – at no additional cost to you. So, when you buy a gift card from Scrip at face value, a percentage of your purchase will be donated directly to CCA. It's an easy way to support our school. There are a few steps to complete before you can shop:

Set up a Scrip Account

1. Visit www.shopwithscrip.com.
2. Click "Family Login" on the left-side of the home page to create a free account.
 - a. Please note: when you provide an email, this is the account Scrip will use to email any Scrip Now e-cards you purchase. Make sure it's one you frequently access.
 - b. After answering two security questions, you'll select the charity you'd like your purchases to support. Classical Christian Academy's Enrollment Number is : 5A75L1C28166.
3. You're ready to shop! There are two ways to pay.
 - a. PAY BY CHECK: You'll need to print out a copy of your online order and write a check out to Classical Christian Academy with "Shop With Scrip" in the memo. Turn in both of these items at the front desk. CCA will approve your order and the gift cards will be e-mailed to you; or if you ordered plastic cards, they will be shipped to the school for you to pick up.
 - i. Please note: there is a shipping charge. If you need to have this order promptly, CCA will ask you to pay the shipping. If CCA is placing a large group order, CCA will pay the shipping. Historically CCA places one or two group orders a year.
 - b. PAY USING PRESTOPAY: This is an online debit account, which is similar to PayPal, and is free to create. When you use PrestoPay, Great Lakes Scrip Company will debit your designated bank account for the face value of the order, plus a small convenience fee of \$0.15, on the day you place your order. (The convenience fee is per order, not per gift-card.) Your account is preapproved, which means you can purchase any ScripNow!, Reload and MyScripWallet giftcards at any time you choose. With this option, you don't have to wait for CCA to approve your order.

Set up a PrestoPay™ Account

1. From the ShopWithScrip.com home page, click "My Account" in the top menu on the far right.
2. Click the PrestoPay link on the left side of the page.
3. Read the agreement, click "Yes, I agree" at the bottom of the page.
4. Enter your bank information.
5. Two deposits will be made in to your bank account, typically within 2 business days of your entering the account information.
6. After you see the deposits in your account, return to this area of ShopWithScrip.com to enter the two amounts and select your personal pin number. You'll use this Pin number to verify your purchases on the Shop With Scrip website and if you choose to set up the MyScripWallet on your smartphone.
7. After successfully verifying your PrestoPay account, you will be sent an approval code. You will need to contact your program coordinator and give them this code to complete the enrollment process.
8. A confirmation email will be sent to you. Please forward this to supportcca@discovercca.org, for us to verify. (We're required by Scrip to do this. There isn't any confidential information shared in this email.)

I am a Scriper!

So, you've completed the registration and are now a CCA Scriper. Congratulations! Here are some tips to get you started.

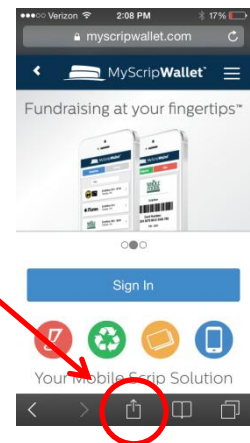
There are three kinds of Scrip gift cards. Some stores/brands offer all three, some only offer one or two options.

1. **Plastic.** These are just like the plastic cards you'd find in a store. They make great gifts. Scrip charges shipping to have them sent to CCA for you to pick up. You can not have them mailed directly to you. If you need to have this order promptly, CCA will ask you to pay the shipping. If CCA is placing a large group order, which we do a couple of times a year, CCA will pay the shipping.
2. **Reload Products.** Don't throw out those plastic cards... you can reload them! Just have the card number ready.
3. **ScripNow.** These are convenient e-gift cards. You buy them on the Scrip page and an email is sent to you with a link. It's easy to forward these onto a friend! When you follow the link in the email, you can choose to print the gift card, or use the gift card number (sometimes there is a PIN provided, too) and shop online.

MyScripWallet

In 2014, Great Lakes Scrip Company launched a mobile site called MyScripWallet. This site has two benefits: first, it allows you to quickly purchase ScripNow cards; second it manages your ScripNow purchases in a virtual wallet for easy access. By adding a shortcut to this website on your smartphone's home screen, you can quickly purchase and access your ScripNow electronic gift cards. Here's how to get started.

1. Make sure you've completed setting up your PrestoPay account.
2. Open your smart phone's internet browser. Visit www.myscripwallet.com.
3. Follow the prompts to log in. You'll use the same email and password that you used to create your Scrip account.
4. At the bottom of your screen, select the action button. You may have to use your finger to "pull down" the screen to make the tools bar appear.



5. Select "Add to Home Screen." This will create a button shortcut on your home screen.
6. When you close your internet browser, and go to your homescreen, you'll see the short cut. When you open the short cut, you'll be asked to login. If you choose "Yes Remember Me" only your email will be remembered. For your purchasing safety, you'll be prompted to enter your password each time.
7. At the top of the screen, you're given three options:
 - a. Order: This gives you an alphabetized list of all of the ScripNow brands.
 - b. Cart: After you've chosen a ScripNow card, it will show up in your cart. To finalize your purchase, you'll need your four-digit PrestoPay Pin number.
 - c. Wallet: This shows all of the ScripNow cards you've purchased on the MyScripWallet site. You simply click one and show it at the register to redeem – and support CCA with your purchase!
